| ARTICLE IV

| BOARD OF DIRECTORS

| Section 1. NUMBER AND QUALIFICATIONS. There shall be a Board of Directors composed of nine (9) registered members of QCFSC who are in good standing and have attained the age of eighteen (18) years. The Directors will be elected by the general membership subject to Section 3. of this Article. **A maximum of two (2) professionals may serve on the Board at any given time.**
