

Queen City Figure Skating Club Merit Award For Higher Education

The Queen City Figure Skating Club Merit Award for Higher Education is awarded to a meritorious registered full time skating member of Queen City Figure Skating Club who is a graduating senior in high school seeking post secondary education. The award is presented at the sole discretion of the QCFSC Merit Award Committee.

Conditions for Eligibility:

To be eligible a candidate must

- 1.) Be an active registered member of QCFSC for three consecutive years and take out a full skating membership in QCFSC. At least one half of dues and USFS fees must be received by November 1st. The Balance must be paid by the second week in January.
- 2.) Be a senior in high school in a full time accredited curriculum.
- 3.) Be applying to a college, university, or institute of higher education for post secondary education.

Criteria For Selection:

Applicant must:

- 1.) Complete Merit Award Application Form
- 2.) Write the essay
- 3.) Secure three recommendations:
 - a) One from a teacher
 - b) One from a counselor
 - c) One from skating coach or skating official
- 4.) Submit an official transcript of grades

All materials must be complete or application will not be considered
